

Acts 20:22-24

“And see, now I go bound in the spirit to Jerusalem, not knowing the things that will happen to me there, 23 except that the Holy Spirit testifies in every city, saying that chains and tribulations await me. 24 But none of these things move me; nor do I count my life dear to myself, so that I may finish my race with joy, and the ministry which I received from the Lord Jesus, to testify to the gospel of the grace of God.”

Circumstances and Ministry

1. Paul's big problem.
Chains and tribulation awaited him in Jerusalem.
2. How Paul responded in a godly way to that big problem.
He didn't allow it to MOVE him.
3. Three reasons why he was able to respond in a godly way.
 1. He valued his relationship and ministry for Jesus more
then his own life.
 2. He cared more about finishing the race God gave
him then the problems that come along the way.
 3. He was willing to be faithful with what God called

Acts 21:1-6

“Now it came to pass, that when we had departed from them and set sail, running a straight course we came to Cos, the following day to Rhodes, and from there to Patara. 2 And finding a ship sailing over to Phoenicia, we went aboard and set sail. 3 When we had sighted Cyprus, we passed it on the left, sailed to Syria, and landed at Tyre; for there the ship was to unload her cargo. 4 And finding disciples, we stayed there seven days. They told Paul through the Spirit not to go up to Jerusalem. 5 When we had come to the end of those days, we departed and went on our way; and they all accompanied us, with wives and children, till we were out of the city. And we knelt down on the shore and prayed. 6 When we had taken our leave of one another, we boarded the ship, and they returned home.”
